The Four Styles of Parenting

- **Authoritarian**
- **Authoritative**
- **Permissive**
- **Uninvolved / Neglectful**

- She quoted the work of Diana Baumrind, Maccoby & Martin.

“ ... conducted a study on more than 100 preschool-age children (Baumrind, 1967). Using naturalistic observation, parental interviews and other research methods, she identified four important dimensions of parenting:

- Disciplinary strategies
- Warmth and nurturance
- Communication styles
- Expectations of maturity and control

Based on these dimensions, Baumrind suggested that the majority of parents display one of three different parenting styles. Further research by Maccoby and Martin also suggested the addition of a fourth parenting style (1983). “
